What is EIP?

The Educational Incentive Program (EIP) is a scholarship program funded by the New York State Office of Children and Family Services (NYS OCFS) which helps providers pay for training and educational activities. EIP has dedicated funding for providers to obtain CPR/FA certification.

Child Care Regulations

New York State Child Day Care regulations require that all child day care programs have at least one caregiver who holds a valid certificate in CPR and First Aid on the premise of the child care program during program hours.

Scholarship Eligibility

EIP for CPR and First Aid scholarship eligibility is based on your employment, level of income and the course or training you choose.

Scholarship awards will be issued for up to **\$125 for classroom training** and up to **\$95 for online training that includes a skills testing component.**
